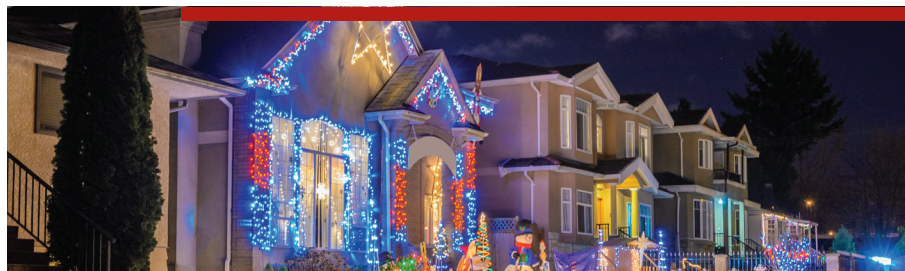

## SnoBiz Warner Robins

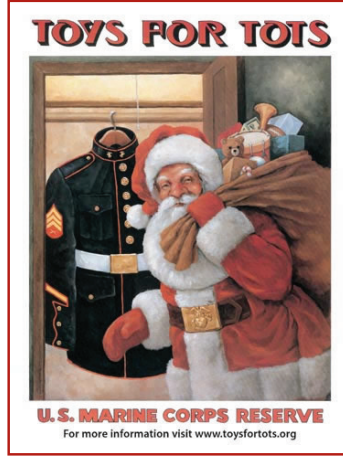
